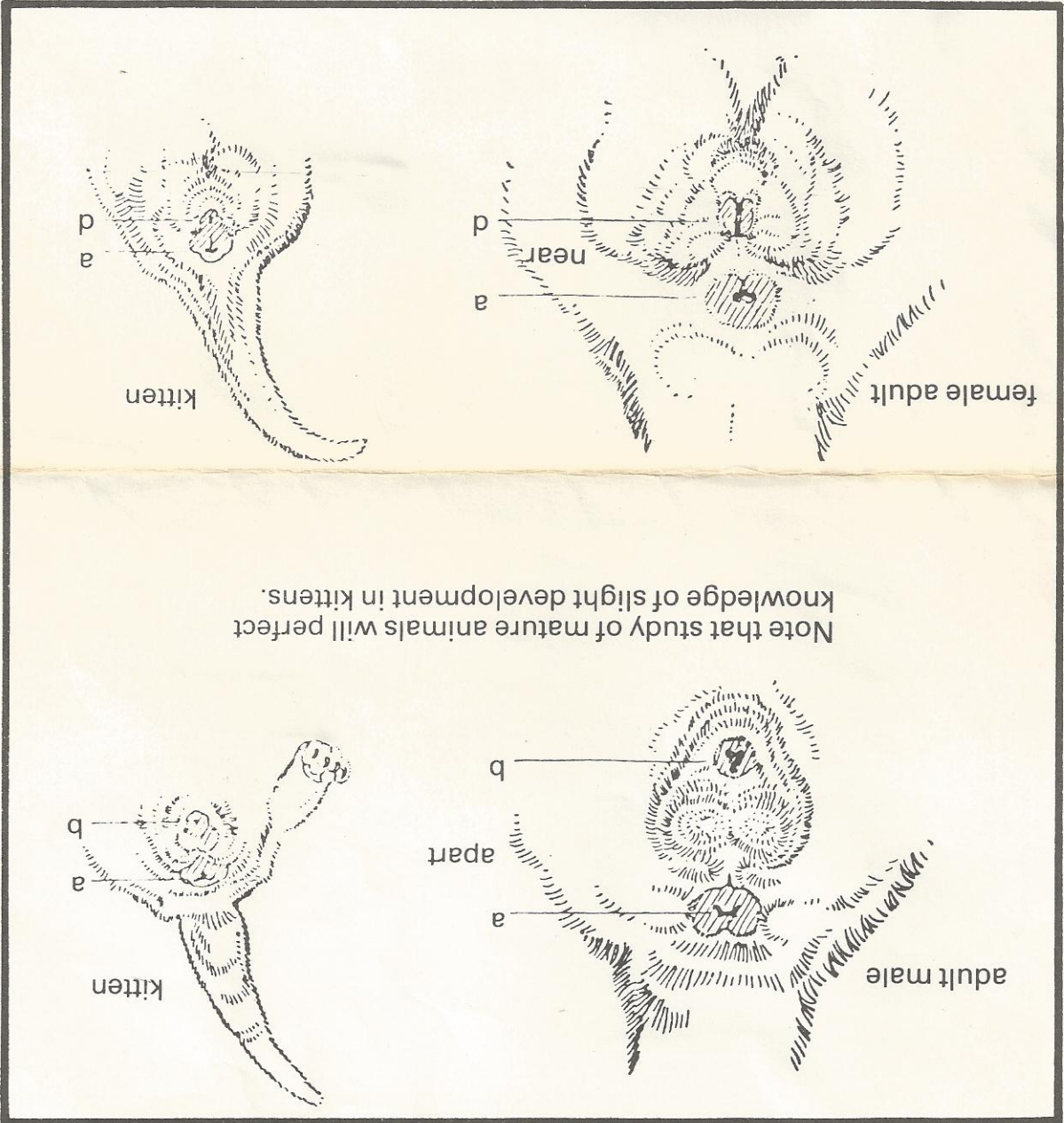


# SEX DIAGRAM

This sex of kittens diagram is published by the Cats' Protection League to help the inexperienced to determine the sex of kittens and so reduce the number of unwanted female kittens that are unwittingly kept and which, in their turn, produce still more unwanted female kittens.



Note that study of mature animals will perfect knowledge of slight development in kittens.

The ability to tell the sex of kittens is easily acquired by reference to the chart and the application of factual knowledge of the sex organs. Allowance must be made for the difference in size between the adult cat and kittens, but the principle is the same.

On the top half of the diagram, "a" indicates the anus and "b" the sheath covering the male organ. Directly behind "b" is the scrotum which fills out as development takes place.

On the bottom half, "a" again indicates the anus and "d", the entrance to the female organ. Never be over-sure and try to decide by a quick glance. Take time and deal with the problem carefully and remember, even the most experienced make mistakes sometimes.
